

**Things to know when signing up to take the Bootcamp for Academic Credit****Who is eligible?**

Any student can earn up to 3 Hours credit subject to the University's tuition rates. This includes Undergrad, grad, PhD's. Anyone signing up for EXP (outside of the Gatton College) must work with the Stuckert Center to go through their process to get registered. B&E students do not have to work with the Stuckert Center, they will work directly with VACE.

**How to Register?**

After completing the online Bootcamp application, VACE must grant an administrative override for the student register for the class. The student will have to provide the UK Student ID number to accomplish this.

**Letter Grade or Pass/Fail?**

All College of Communication iNET certificate and graduate students must take Bootcamp for a letter grade. Beyond this, all students are responsible for checking with their advisor to see if the letter grade is required vs, pass/fail.

**Should Students Keep Track of Their Hours?**

All B&E and EXP for-credit options require that students are responsible for keeping up with their hours worked on their Bootcamp project, 48 hours equals 1 hour credit.
